



## Concession Stand Policy

1. All parents of OLS athletes will be required to work up to 8 hours in the concession stand.
2. A \$100 concession stand check will be required at the time of registration.
  - Checks need to be **post dated 03/01/2011**
3. Upon fulfilling your concession stand requirement your check will be returned to you.
4. It is **YOUR** responsibility to contact the concession stand coordinator ASAP if you cannot work your scheduled shift.
  - You may try to reschedule your assignment based on availability, or
  - You may switch days and times with another family, but the coordinator **MUST** be notified, or
  - You can switch to the Concession Stand Buyout Program (CSBP).
  - **NOTE:** Your check will be deposited if there is failure to work your assigned shift without prior notification.
5. Concession stand assignments will be available at uniform pick up.
  - You will be able to choose available times and dates.
  - Anyone who does not sign-up will be assigned a time and date.
  - The schedule will be posted in the concession stand as well as online.

## Concession Stand Buyout Program

1. All OLS families are eligible for the CSBP.
2. The cost is \$100 per family.
3. Once the fee is paid, it covers all the children in the family and exempts the parents from working any concession stand duty for the current sport year (May 2010-May 2011).

## Other Concession Stand Information

- Concession stand is **NOW** a required commitment to participate in any or all OLS sports.
- Concession stand assignments are **NOT** affiliated with a particular sport
  - Meaning... you may be scheduled to work the concession stand during volleyball season even if your child(ren) do not participate in that sport.
- **ADULT WORKERS ONLY**
  - Children should be in the concession stand on a limited basis.
